2. Students will not be permitted in Examination Hall without PRN number, valid Admit Card OR Identity Proof.
3. The University reserves right to make changes in Examination Schedule and Centers.
4. Students should follow instructions given by the Supervisor/ Superintendent of Examination.
5. Students are advised to write their **examination seat number** and NOT Admit Card number on the answerbooks.
6. Seat numbers will be displayed on the Notice Board of the Examination Centers, two days prior to the date of commencement of the examination.
7. Students are forbidden to take any books, papers, chits and mobile phones etc. into the Examination Hall.
8. Students will be permitted to appear for examination only in the subjects stated in the Admit Card.
9. If at any time, it is detected that the student has failed to satisfy any of the requirements prescribed under the rules OR that the university has not received her examination forms and examination fee within the prescribed time limit, her appearance at the examination shall be invalid and her performance at the examination will not be taken into consideration by the University.


The broad categories of Unfair Means resorted to by students at the University / College /  
Institution Examinations and the quantum of punishment for each category thereof  
(As per Appendix I to Prevailing Ordinance No. O.71(13)(J) related to Examinations)

Sr. No.	Nature of malpractice	Quantum of punishment
(12) a)	Impersonation at the University / College / Institution examination.	Exclusion of the student from University or College or Institution examination for five additional examinations. (Both the students if impersonator is University or College or Institute student)
b)	Impersonation by a University/ College / Institution student at S.S.C / H.S.C. / any other examinations.	Exclusion of the student from University or College or Institution examination for five additional examinations.
(13)	Revealing identity in any form in the answer written or in any other part of the answer-book by the student at the University or College or Institution examination.	Annulment of the student from University or College or Institution examination for full.
(14)	Found having written on palms or on the body, or on the clothes while in the examination.	Annulment of the student from University or College or Institution examination for full.
(15)	All other malpractices not covered in the aforesaid categories.	Annulment of the student from University or College or Institution examination for full, and severe punishment upon the gravity of the offence.
(16)	If on previous occasion a disciplinary action was taken against a student for malpractice used at examination and she is caught again for malpractices used at the examinations, in this event she shall be dealt with severely. Enhanced punishment can be imposed on such students. This enhanced punishment may extend to double the punishment provided for the offence, when committed at the second or subsequent examination	
(17)	Practical/Dissertation/Thesis/Project Report examination: Student involved in malpractices at Practical/ Dissertation /Thesis/Project Report examinations shall be dealt with as per the punishment provided for the theory examination.	
(18)	The Competent Authority, in addition to the above mentioned punishments, may impose a fine not exceeding Rs. Five hundred on the student declared guilty.	

(Note : \* The term "Annulment of Performance in Full" includes performance of the student at the theory as well as annual practical examination, but does not include performance at term work, project work & dissertation examinations unless malpractice used thereat.)



DO'S	:	1.	Student must carry the Identity Card.
		2.	Student must carry the Examination Admit Ticket.
		3.	Student must reach the Examination Hall / Block, atleast 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the Examination.
		4.	Students should maintain silence during the entire period of examination.
		5.	Students should keep their bags and belongings outside the Examination Hall. The Supervisor shall not be responsible for any loss. Kindly do not keep any valuable in your bag.
		6.	Student should fill correct information on the answerbook / OMR Barcode Sheets.
		7.	Student should write all the details carefully on the Main answerbook, number of Supplements, Medium of Instructions, etc.
		8.	Student should obey the instructions given by the Junior Supervisor / Superintendent of Examination, in the Examinations Hall from time to time.
		9.	Student should submit answerbook to Junior Supervisor before leaving the Examination Hall.



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
